MINUTES FOR THE BONNER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING

May 10, 2022 – 9:00 A.M. Bonner County Administration Building 1500 Hwy 2, Suite 338, Sandpoint, ID

On Tuesday, May 10, 2022 the Bonner County Commissioners met for their regularly scheduled meeting with Commissioners Connolly, Bradshaw & McDonald present. Commissioner McDonald called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. The Invocation was presented by Dan York and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

ADOPT ORDER OF THE AGENDA

Commissioner Connolly made a motion to adopt the order of agenda as presented. Commissioner Bradshaw seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.
