



Re: Rescind Resolution 21-86 - Return ARPA Funds

On October 15th, I was notified by Bonner County Clerk Michel Rosedale of Rule 9. on the Compliance with Applicable Law and Regulations as related to the "U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND AWARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS."

Rule 9. states: "Compliance with Applicable Law and Regulations. a. Recipient agrees to comply with the requirements of section 603 of the Act, regulations adopted by Treasury pursuant to section 603(f) of the Act, and guidance issued by Treasury regarding the foregoing. Recipient also agrees to comply with all other applicable federal statutes, regulations, and executive orders, and Recipient shall provide for such compliance by other parties in any agreements it enters into with other parties relating to this award."

In light of the discovery of the strings attached to the use of ARPA monies, I will not follow applicable federal statutes, regulations, and executive orders of President Joe Biden!

The Bonner County Sheriff's Office Jail received ARPA funds in the sum of \$18,486.11 to assist in covering anticipated COVID related expenses. Bonner County Jail would like to rescind this request and return these funds back to the county ARPA fund.

I am requesting to open the budget and remove the \$18,486.11 out of the Sheriff's Office Jail Budget.
