SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT BONNER COUNTY EMS

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 67-2808 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may, if it is found competitive solicitation is impractical, disadvantageous, or unreasonable, acquire products in any manner the County deems best.

WHEREAS, Bonner County Board of Commissioners has determined that a competitive solicitation for pricing of remounting one F-450 4x4 ambulance is impractical, disadvantageous or unreasonable under current market circumstances and that the procurement of this specified ambulance shall be a sole source purchase from Braun Northwest, Inc. The procurement shall have been published in the official newspaper of this political subdivision at least fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the award of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Bonner County that Bonner County EMS shall be authorized to enter a sole source purchase contract with Braun Northwest, Inc. for the reasons stated above. Such purchase shall occur only after fourteen (14) calendar days of published notice of intent and with no formal objection received from that published notice.






WHEREAS, Bonner County EMS has adequate funds in account 99918-9310 Capitol Buildings; and


WHEREAS, these funds need to be used to cover an unanticipated ambulance replacement; and



Adopted as a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho on the 23rd day of March, 2021.


