WHEREAS, these ES&S Automarks became antiquated when we purchased our HART Touchwriters with the HAVA grant funds nearly 5 years ago, and


WHEREAS, these ES&S Automarks have no known market value anymore...as they are no longer used anywhere in Idaho, and




