WHEREAS, Idaho Code §34-302 requires the Board to establish suitable polling places for each voting precinct not less than 30 days prior to any election, and;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §34-1006 requires the establishment of not less than one absent electors' polling place for each election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the table attached hereto as Exhibit A, sets for the name of each precinct as well as the name of the building and physical location of each building to be used as a polling place, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the absent electors polling place shall be located at the Elections Office in Suite 124 on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Bonner County Administrative Office Building who's address is 1500 Highway 2 in Sandpoint Idaho.

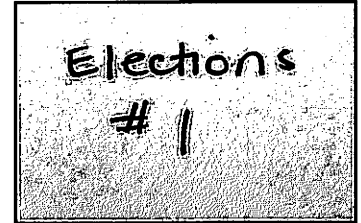
