NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Sagle precinct will be declared a Mail-Ballot Precinct for and only for the November 2nd, 2021 election, and that it will revert back to a regular precinct thereafter.

Designation of Sagle as a Mail Ballot Precinct for the November 2nd, 2021 election ONLY. Re:

Description: I.C. §34-308 Mail Ballot Precincts. We are able to designate a precinct as a Mail Ballot Precinct if the registered electors are 140 or fewer. We have only five (5) voters in our Sagle precinct who are qualified to vote in the November 2nd, 2021 LPOSD trustee zone 2 question. I have asked the SOS if we are, as a result, able to declare Sagle a Mail Only Precinct for the November election ONLY, and they gave me permission. This will mean we don't have to staff (and pay) a polling place from 7am to 8:30pm on Election Day for the possibility of having 5 voters come.

> As a result, we will mail all 5 voters a ballot just like absentee ballots with the same safe guards and they will be returned just like all the other absentee ballots. They will all have the ability to vote.
