WHEREAS, Bonner County wants to properly fund EMS's budget with the ARPA funds for things it needs now and through the end of fiscal year 2021.



The foregoing was duly enacted as a Resolution, by the Board of County Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho, on the 21st day of September, 2021.




