SOLID WASTE

BUDGET ADJUSTMENT FY21

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-1605 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may only adjust the budget as adopted, provided that the budget increase is financed by revenues that were not reasonably estimable at the time of budgeting; and,

WHEREAS, at the time of budgeting for FY 2021 it could not be forecasted that Solid Waste would receive more revenues than anticipated from residential, commercial and gate fees and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County that the Clerk is authorized to open the budget and increase line item 02380-7350 by \$497,401.73 from these unanticipated revenues.

ADOPTED as a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County upon which a majority vote was had on the 19th day of October, 2021.


