CARRYOVER FY2021 BUDGETED FUNDS TO FY2022

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 and 31-4603 provides that in the event of any unforeseen contingency arising, which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the budget, the Board of County Commissioners, by unanimous vote thereof, shall have the right to make an appropriation from the statutory reserves to the office, department, service, agency, or institution in which said contingency arises, in such amount shall be determined by Resolution of said Board, and;

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office Marine Division has consistently exceeded the line item budget for gasoline, which prompted an increase in the FY22 budget. However, gasoline costs in FY21 still exceeded this increased amount by approximately \$9,954.02. Given the recent unexpected rise in fuel costs, potential future increases, and the fact that on-the-water fuel is significantly higher than prices at roadside gasoline facilities, it is projected that the Marine Division will exceed the budgeted gasoline costs by an amount that cannot be covered within the existing budget. A sufficient fuel budget is imperative to maintain Patrol vessels that are prepared to deploy in routine and emergency public safety situations. These cost increases were not anticipated when the budget was prepared and are outside of the Sheriff's Office control, and;

WHEREAS, Bonner County wants to properly fund the Sheriff's Office budget through the end of FY21.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho authorizes the Clerk to open the 2022 Marine Division grant revenue budget and decrease line item 03479-4700 in the amount of \$18,000.00 and open the Sheriff's Office Marine Division budget and increase line item 03479-7000 by \$18,000.00.
