WHEREAS, the Idaho Legislature has repealed Title 31 Chapter 35 effective March 29, 2022;

WHEREAS, the financial resources available to the county to adequately and properly carry out these duties are limited;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution supersedes previous resolutions for indigent assistance, and that the terms of the Resolution can be revised at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners. (95-58, 96-40 AND 96-52, 11-78)

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Board of Bonner County Commissioners this 14th day of June, 2022, repeal the Indigent Assistance Description and Delineation of Medical Services Policy and be effective upon execution hereof.
