


**WHEREAS**, this extension will be in effect until any threat to life and /or property by the flooding is no longer an issue.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho hereby authorize the Bonner County Marine Patrol to extend the "No Wake" zones to 500 feet in all navigable waters in Bonner County until further notice.

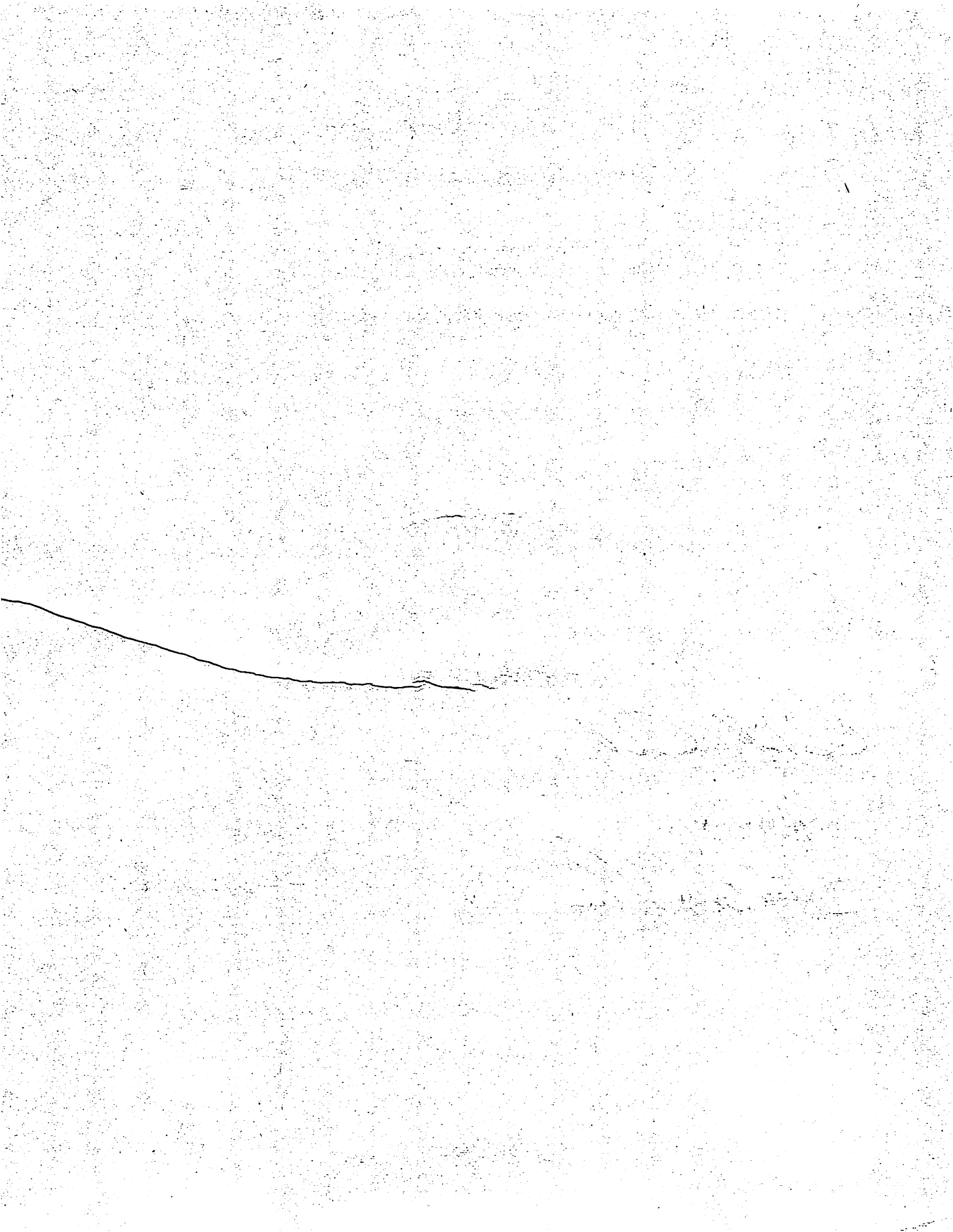

Re: Resolution extending "No Wake" zone to 500 feet on all navigable waters in Bonner County


