

RESOLUTION NO. 22 - 65

Coroner

General Fund Statutory Reserve Appropriation

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 and 31-4603 provide that in the event of any unforeseen contingency arising, which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the budget, and which shall require the expenditure of money not provided for in the budget, the Board of County Commissioners, by unanimous vote thereof, shall have the right to make an appropriation from the statutory reserves to the office, department, service, agency or institution in which said contingency arises, in such amount as shall be determined by resolution of said Board, and

WHEREAS, the Coroner's Budget is projected to incur roughly \$10,000 more in autopsies than budgeted, and


WHEREAS, Bonner County wants to properly reflect and account for the deficit in the Coroner's 2022 Budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho authorizes the Clerk to transfer from the 2022 General Fund Statutory Reserve, line item 01120-7860 (General Fund 5% Statutory Reserve) in the amount of \$10,000 to the 2022 Coroner's budget and increase line item 00106-8310 (Autopsies) in the amount of \$10,000.

The foregoing was duly enacted as a Resolution, by the Board of County Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho, by *unanimous vote* on the 30th day of August, 2022.


