WHEREAS, a public hearing was held pursuant to Idaho Code § 63-1311A after which the Bonner County Board of Commissioners considered input given by the public; and,





APPROVED THIS 9th day of April 2025, as a Resolution of the Bonner County Board of Commissioners.


