Solid Waste recommends the dissolution of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) and any associated appointments as an independent advisory body.

Over time, the SWAC has experienced ongoing challenges in securing sufficient public participation to meet quorum requirements, limiting its ability to effectively function as intended. Despite efforts to recruit members of the public, the number of applicants consistently falls short of what is needed for the committee to operate in compliance with quorum rules.

Considering these circumstances, it is recommended that the SWAC be formally dissolved. In its place. Solid Wate staff will meet with the Board of Commissioners in a public meeting at least once per month to provide updates, receive guidance, and discuss solid waste related matters.
