EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS FOR THE BONNER COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Bonner County Board of County Commissioners is authorized pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-807 to accept donations on behalf of Bonner County; and

WHEREAS, Bonner County Emergency Management receives donations to support the Emergency Management Volunteer Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it to be in the best interest of Bonner County to formally accept financial contributions and ensure, and physical items donated that all donations are accounted for and used solely for the benefit of the Emergency Management Volunteer Program; and

WHEREAS, all monetary donations received for the Emergency Management Volunteer Program shall be deposited into the designated restricted account, **EMVP**, and shall be used exclusively for volunteer program expenses, equipment, training, recognition, and other authorized Emergency Management Volunteer Program purposes. All physical donated items shall be properly documented, inventoried, and tracked in accordance with applicable Bonner County policies and procedures and shall be used solely for authorized Emergency Management Volunteer Program purposes.

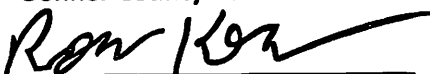
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bonner County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The Board hereby accepts donations made to the Bonner County Emergency Management Volunteer Program pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-807.
2. All monetary donations shall be deposited into the designated restricted account identified as **EMVP**.
3. Funds deposited into the EMVP restricted account shall be used solely for the support and operation of the Bonner County Emergency Management Volunteer Program, consistent with applicable county policies and state law.
4. The Clerk, Auditor, Treasurer, and Emergency Management are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution.

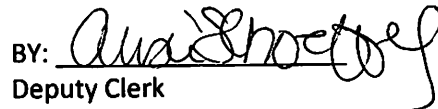
