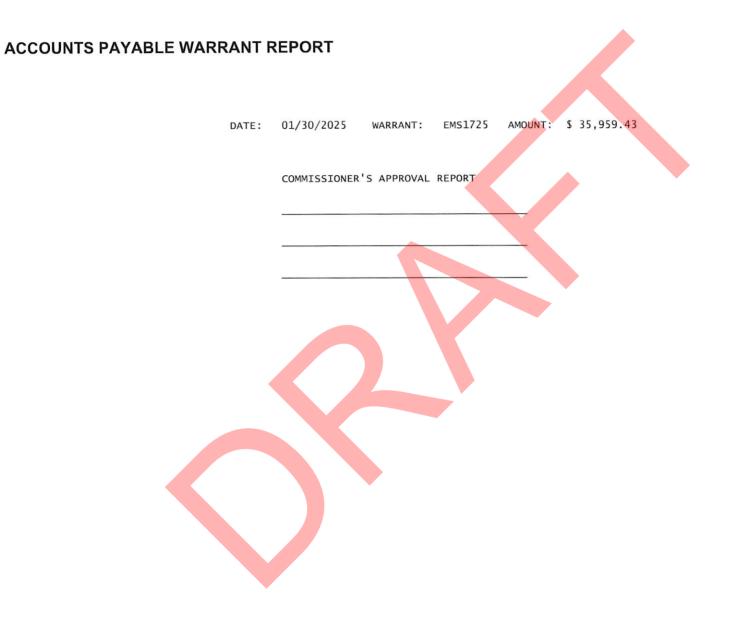

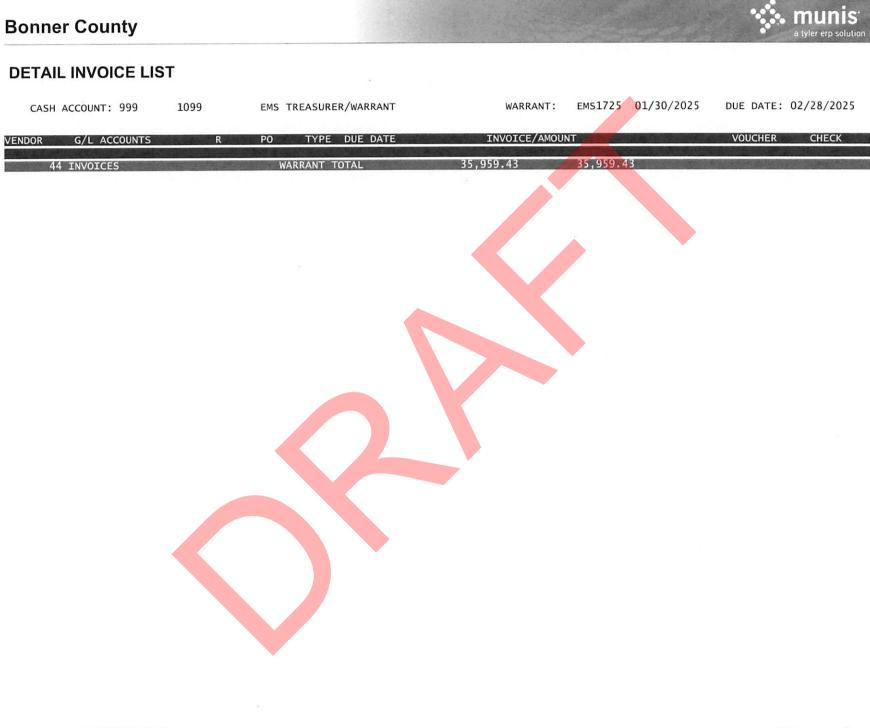

Budget Update

Tax levy first payment was deposited January 23, 2025.

The cash position on January 23 was \$402,720 which included outstanding checks.

This meant without the TAN we would have been in the red \$98,000, by the time our first tax deposit arrived.

TAN can remain available until January 2026, which would require a much simpler process to extend the maturity date.

Still projecting >900K cash position by end of FY25

Budget Update [2024 YTD vs 2025 YTD]

YTD employee cost were 319,803 higher in 2024

YTD revenue is 86,376 lower than 2024

2024 YTD Revenue \$2,529,172 YTD Expenses \$2,579,304 2025 YTD Revenue \$2,442,797 YTD Expenses \$1,610,039

Personnel Attrition Update

Through attrition down 3 positions since January 1.

Additional (4th) position could be leaving this month or March.

We can lose up to 6 positions to remain at our minimum staffing levels.

We can remain at minimal staffing levels to build up reserves to ensure continuous service into the future.

How does this affect deployment model

Currently Paramedic chase vehicle scheduled full time in Priest River Cutting this to only our busy summer season we could staff with part-time staff

This does not reduce the number of ambulances on the road daily

This falls inside of our minimum staffing policy

This provides the normal 4 ALS ambulances and 1 Paramedic fly car

What does attrition do to the budget

3 positions currently closed out returns roughly \$355,000/yr to our cash flow

Additional attrition is around \$115,000/yr per employee depending on wage

Currently payroll is averaging \$153,000 per pay period or \$3,984,000/yr

Current attrition of 3 staff members predicted average \$140,000 per pay period or \$3,640,000/yr

Additional attrition up to 6 will lead to additional cash towards reserve building

We are hoping to be able to add additional slots for part-time staff, specifically for full-time to part-time positions that do not require FTO.

Direction Forward as a District

The legal opinion is we could continue to utilize county administrative services, however we we need some kind of document outlining the relationship

The county could charge for those services or not

We could realign ourselves like other special districts ie FD's and outsource current services or accept them internally.

Would like the opportunity to continue to work on what this will look like with my current opinion leaning towards option 2

COLLECTION AGREEMENT

Bonner County EMS (BCEMS) by this agreement with North Idaho Credit Corp (NIC) retains the service of NIC to attempt collection of bona-fide accounts and or returned checks as may be individually assigned to NIC by BCEMS. For the purpose of check collection, BCEMS agrees to post and keep visible at each point of sale an NIC notice "A Collection Fee of \$20.00 will be charged on each returned check."

NIC will acknowledge receipt of each assigned account, and shall use reasonable efforts to attempt collection. The contingent collection fee charged BCEMS shall be 33 percent and pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2358(1)(b) this shall be payable by the debtor and will be added to the amount assigned. BCEMS agrees to fully comply with all requirements of said Idaho Code in order for the fee to be the responsibility of the debtor. In the event that the contingent collection fee of 33 percent is deemed to not be the responsibility of the debtor, BCEMS agrees to pay the contingent fee on collected funds out of the amount assigned NIC. All interest that shall accrue after assignment shall be retained by NIC. If legal action is necessary or the account is forwarded out of this area, the contingent collection fee will be an additional 7 percent for a total of 40 percent. The additional fee of 7 percent will be paid out as a commission from the amount assigned NIC. In consideration of this additional fee charged BCEMS, NIC will advance all legal costs of suit and BCEMS shall not be responsible for those costs advanced. Any legal costs and attorney fees awarded NIC, as prevailing party in any legal action will be added to the amount assigned and shall be repaid NIC out of first monies recovered from a debtor. NIC shall within 30 days after the close of each calendar month report to BCMES all collections made during said month and remit said net amounts.

BCEMS agrees to make no payment arrangement with a debtor after assignment, but will instruct debtor to contact NIC. BCEMS shall immediately notify NIC of any post assignment direct payments and or contacts by debtors and shall hold NIC harmless from any liability resulting for failure to do so. Further, BCEMS shall hold NIC harmless and waive any claim resulting from any alleged damages resulting from failure to pursue an account or the lapse of any applicable Statute of Limitations. NIC shall hold BCEMS harmless from any liability resulting from NIC collection effort. NIC shall have exclusive authority to determine which accounts to pursue through collection or litigation and does not guarantee collection.

BCEMS hereby grants power of attorney and appoints NIC its attorney-in-fact granting to it the right to endorse any checks, drafts or money orders received on behalf of and/or payable to BCEMS for deposit into the NIC trust account.

This agreement is terminable upon thirty days written notice by either party. If so requested, NIC will return any unpaid accounts except those that are in litigation, judgment or are in payment arrangements, provided any monies due NIC by BCEMS have been fully paid.

CONTRACT WITH ABORTION PROVIDERS- To the extent the Agreement is subject to the use of public funds, Contractor hereby certifies that it is not, and will not, for the duration of the Agreement, become an abortion provider or an affiliate of an abortion provider as those terms are defined in the No Public Funds for Abortions Act (Idaho Code §§ 18-8701 et seq.).

TAN info

Tax levy first payment was deposited January 23, 2025.

The cash position on January 23 was \$402,720 which included outstanding checks.

This meant without the TAN we would have been in the red \$98,000, by the time our first tax deposit arrived.

TAN info

February 3 cash position - \$2,194,125.40

TAN Interest Accrued - \$4,300

TAN payoff would stop accruing interest.

Current TAN can remain available until January 2026, which would require a much simpler process to extend the maturity date.

Need to assure we have enough to make it until next levy deposit (end of July)

Based on current projections between 150K and 200K by July end

Personnel Attrition Update

Through attrition down 3 positions since January 1.

We can lose up to 3 additional positions to remain at our minimum staffing levels.

We can remain at minimal staffing levels to build up reserves to ensure continuous service into the future.

How does this affect deployment model

Currently Paramedic chase vehicle scheduled full time in Priest River

Cutting this to only our busy summer season we could staff with part-time staff

Currently moving this position as needed during sick call offs

This does not reduce the number of ambulances on the road daily

This falls inside of our minimum staffing policy

This provides the normal 4 ALS ambulances and 1 Paramedic fly car

What does attrition do to the budget

3 positions currently closed out since Jan 1

Additional attrition is dependent on the employee's wage

Currently payroll is averaging \$153,000 per pay period or \$3,984,000/yr

Current attrition of 3 staff members predicted average \$140,000 per pay period or \$3,640,000/yr

Additional attrition up to 6 will lead to additional cash towards reserve building

We are adding additional slots for part-time staff, specifically, full-time to part-time positions that do not require FTO.

Direction Forward as a District

The current legal opinion (Bill Wilson) is we are a district based on Idaho 31-3908

We could continue to utilize county administrative services, however we we need some kind of document outlining the relationship

The county could elect to charge or not charge for the services

We could realign ourselves like other special districts ie FD's and outsource current services or accept them internally. Currently working on quotes from ICRMP, iii-A, Local Bookkeeping CPA Services for (AP, Payroll etc)

Will continue working on this through the coming months

Idaho Statute 31-3908

31-3908. Ambulance district authorized – **districts formed before July 1, 2020**. The provisions set forth in this section shall govern an ambulance district formed prior to July 1, 2020:

The board of county commissioners shall be the governing board of an ambulance service district created pursuant to this section and shall exercise the duties and responsibilities provided in <u>chapter 39, title 31</u>, Idaho Code.

The board of county commissioners is authorized by resolution to create an ambulance district **capital improvement account**. The board may dedicate all or a portion of the fees and taxes collected pursuant to this chapter to the capital improvement account for the purpose of purchasing necessary buildings, land or equipment for the operation of the district. The board is further authorized to carry over and add to the funds in the account from year to year in order to make the purchases authorized by this subsection.
