- RR crossings-LHTAC Safety Grant. We are still waiting to see if we can add the rest of the RR crossings in. I think we should move forward with getting quotes as if they are not being added due to time, getting better pricing and our permits expire this year. There is a 50% chance that these will be added back in and we would not know until August.
- Kripple Creek Rd, we have received the legal documentation from Steve Barnhart to move forward with bringing this road in as a non - maintained public road. Tom and I have looked at this road and it does meet the requirements for a public non - maintained Rd and the documents have been sent to legal for review.
