May 19, 2026 Primary Election

Election Day Polling Places will be open from 8 AM to 8 PM on May 19th

Ballot Questions

- Ballot Question Submission Deadline March 13th : Political subdivisions must submit ballot language to the county clerk for any bond, levy, initiative, referendum, or other question to be placed on the ballot for the May 19th Election – Idaho Code 34-106

Voter Pre-Registration Deadline

- **May 8, 2026 Deadline- Voter Registration must be received** by the county clerk for the May 19th Election. The deadline is 5 PM for paper applications or until midnight for the online applications. Voters can register to vote at the polls on Election Day.

Absentee Voting

- The request can be dropped off, mailed, emailed, or faxed to the Elections Office. The deadline to request a mail-in absentee ballot for the May 19th Election is May 8th at 5:00 PM.

Early Voting

- Early voting will be available at the County Elections Office starting **May 4, 2026 through May 15, 2026**. Early voting hours are **Monday through Friday from 9AM to 5PM**.

Sample Ballots

- Sample Ballots will be available the first week of April for the May 19, 2026 Election.

Logic and Accuracy Test

- The Logic and Accuracy test is open to the public and will be on Wednesday, May 13, 2026 at 10:00 AM. Location will be in the Elections Office, Suite 124 at the Bonner County Administration Building located at 1500 Hwy 2 in Sandpoint.
