The applicants are requesting an Administrative Temporary Special Use Permit within the existing Granite Hill Rock Pit which is located on about 35.5 acres along the old highway 95 and Granite loop Road. The property is zoned Rural 5 (R-5). The project is located off Hwy 95 in Section 26, Township 54 North, Range 3 West, Boise-Meridian.
