In regard to our phone conversation, PHD does not have any jurisdiction for the camping scenario you described. It sounds like you are providing space for individuals to set up tents or park an RV to spend the night at the wedding venue premises following an event. Since there are no plumbed structures or RV hook-ups there is nothing that would require permitting and subsurface sewage disposal. PHD does not write any kind of letter granting approval for anything that does not fall under the State of Idaho sewage rules regulatory authority.
