Dear Applicant,

The Bonner County Zoning Commission APPROVED the referenced application with conditions.

Commissioner Pound moved to approve this request FILE V0030-25, for a Variance to the impervious surface limits, to allow for 52% coverage, where 35% is the maximum, and to the shoreline standards, to allow a 0-foot setback, where 40 feet is required, for the placement of 290 sq. ft. of riprap along the shoreline, finding that it is in accord with the Bonner County Revised Code as enumerated in the following conclusions of law:

### Conclusion 1

Conditions apply to the property that **do not** apply generally to other properties in the same zone or vicinity, which conditions are a result of lot size, shape, topography, or other circumstances over which the applicant has no control.

### Conclusion 2

Special conditions and circumstances **did not** result from the actions of the applicant.

### Conclusion 3

The granting of the variance **is not** in conflict with the public interest in that it **will not** be detrimental to the public health, safety, or welfare, or materially injurious to properties or improvements in the vicinity of the subject parcel or lot. (Ord. 559, 1-4-2017)

This is based upon the evidence submitted up to the time the Staff Report was prepared and testimony received at this hearing. I further move to adopt the

reasoned statement as discussed in deliberation at this hearing and the analysis as set forth in the Staff Report (or as amended during this hearing) and direct planning staff to draft the reasoned statement to reflect this motion as set forth in Idaho Code section 67-6535, have the Chair sign, and transmit to all interested parties. This action does not result in a taking of private property.

Commissioner Mauk seconded the motion.

**Voted** upon and the Chair declared the Motion passed, unanimously.

**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:**

- A-1.** Only the development highlighted on the site plan has been reviewed for variance standards. All other development shown must comply with Bonner County Revised Code.
- A-2.** This variance shall not supersede any deed restrictions.
- A-3.** An approved Stormwater Management Plan shall be obtained.
- A-4.** Building Location Permits may be required.
- A-5.** The Floodplain Development Permit, FDP2025-0030, shall be completed and approved.
- A-6.** Plat restrictions shall be followed. The approval of the variance only grants relief from the requirements of BCRC, not those imposed by the recorded plat of Sunset Bay Estates, Instrument #453472.
- A-7.** Any deviation from the plat requirements of Sunset Bay Estates, Instrument #453472, will require a plat vacation or approved Minor Notational Change.
- A-8.** The existing dock must remain separated from the shoreline, to prevent the creation of a boardwalk, as per BCRC 12-711 (B)(1).
- A-9.** The existing Stormwater Management Plan, file #ST0003-25 shall be completed and approved.
- A-10.** Wall is not to exceed 4 feet in height, as measured from grade.



8003, Idaho Code (*Idaho Code §67-6535(3)*).




**F. Standards review**

BCRC 12-234 specifies that "Staff, the commission and/or board shall review the particular facts and circumstances of each proposal submitted and shall find adequate evidence showing that:

- (a) **Conditions apply to the property that do not apply generally to other properties in the same zone or vicinity, which conditions are a result of lot size, shape, topography, or other circumstances over which the applicant has no control.**

**Applicant:** *"The subject property is located within R-5 zoning district, which is common throughout Bonner County, including both shoreline and inland areas. While R-5 zoning is applied broadly, many R-5 zoned parcels do not share the same level of topographic constraint as this site. Unlike many similarly zoned properties, this parcel is situated directly on the Pend Oreille River and features steep, rocky walls and sharp elevation changes that limit the development area. These conditions severely restrict the options for placing structures and infrastructure in compliance with current code standards.*

*The subject property contains physical characteristics that are both unique and challenging compared to surrounding parcels within the same zoning district. The parcel is constrained by natural features such as steep, rocky walls and significant elevation changes that limit buildable area. The rocky walls were already on site prior to the owner purchasing the property. Many of the rocky walls were built on other parcels in conjunction with the rocky walls on the applicant's parcel. These conditions are beyond the applicant's control and are a result of the parcel's natural topography and configuration from the developer during initial development of the subdivision. As a result of these limitations, the developable footprint is restricted to a narrow and irregular portion of the lot closer to the shoreline, making it infeasible to meet certain ordinance requirements – such as the maximum impervious surface coverage and standard shoreline setbacks. For example, in order to maintain shoreline structural integrity and access, additional impervious areas and a properly engineered riprap are necessary. Neighboring properties to the applicants have seen shoreline deterioration due to a lack of slope stability measures."*

**Staff:** The subject lot is approximately .38-acres, mostly flat, with sloping near the shoreline. This is similar to other properties in the vicinity, and along Lake Pend Oreille. The subject parcel is zoned as Rural 5, which has a lot size minimum of 5-acres. The subject lot size is far below the standard for Rural 5 zoning, creating a condition that generally applies in the same vicinity, but not the same zoning.

**(b) Special conditions and circumstances do not result from the actions of the applicant.**

**Applicant:** *"These site limitations and proposed improvements are not the result of any action taken by the applicant. The parcel has not been reduced, subdivided, or altered in any way that would have contributed to these constraints. The current lot shape and natural features have existed prior to ownership, and all design decisions have been made in response to these pre-existing conditions and occurred at the time of the original subdivision by that developer. Many of neighboring parcels have been afforded a larger impervious surface area within the same zone. The parcel to the southwest contains 46.05% impervious surface which is similar to the current impervious surface percentage as the applicant. The parcel to the northeast contains 39.5% impervious surface. North of the property there is a parcel with 47% impervious surface due to similar site constraints. Allowing for the requested variances will not give the property owner special conditions that are not already shared by neighboring properties.*

*Allowing for riprap within the Shoreline Vegetative Buffer 40' setback will not provide a special condition but will be used to help protect the shoreline along with the vegetation requirements of 12-714: Shoreline Vegetative Buffer. North of the*

*property are numerous parcels with varying types of riprap within the 40' Shoreline Vegetative Buffer."*

**Staff:** The applicants purchased the subject parcel in 2019, under instrument #937370. It appears they removed trees from the parcel, but did not change the size, shape, or existing characteristics of the parcel, or its structures, nor did they change the zoning of the property. One of the existing walls is a continuation of a retaining wall from the neighboring property, which existed prior to their purchase of this subject property.

- (c) The granting of the variance is not in conflict with the public interest in that it will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, or welfare, or materially injurious to properties or improvements in the vicinity of the subject parcel or lot.**

**Applicant:** *"Granting these variances would not conflict with the public interest, nor would it negatively affect public health, safety, or welfare. The proposed increase in impervious surface area will be managed responsibly with appropriate stormwater mitigation. The shoreline vegetation buffer will remain largely intact, with strategic placement of riprap above the ordinary high-water mark to control erosion, and will be enhanced with native and beneficial plant species per Title 12 Appendix B. These improvements are compatible with surrounding shoreline uses, pose no threat to neighboring properties, and reflect best practices for sustainable development in challenging terrain. It is in the public interest to protect vulnerable shoreline areas that have increases in sedimentation and siltation due to a lack of shoreline stabilization. Decreasing sedimentation and siltation by utilizing riprap is the best management practice to protect waterways and the aquatic life in them. Excess sedimentation and siltation suffocate fish eggs from the free-floating oxygen in the water and kill them which leads to a reduction in reproduction. Sediment and siltation can also contain excess phosphate and nitrogen that leads to poor water quality."*

**Staff:** According to the plans submitted, the riprap along the shoreline would be considered a "seawall" by planning staff. Merriam-Webster defines a seawall as "a wall or embankment to protect the shore from erosion or to act as a breakwater." Per BCRC 12-712 (A), seawalls are exempt from the shoreline setback requirement. This portion of the Variance request appears unnecessary. Idaho Department of Environmental Quality submitted a comment addressing the importance of impervious surface limits for water quality. While many lots in the area may also be exceeding these limits, allowing this property to also exceed the limits appears to have a compounded effect on the water quality concern in this vicinity. When the lots were first created, the developer considered the impacts, and placed restrictions on the development. The plat of Sunset Bay Estates, Instrument #453472, notes the following two restrictions:

*5. A 25 foot Riparian Setback Zone has been established along the Pend Oreille River and the Bay Inlet. Existing vegetation shall be maintained or enhanced.*

*6. A 40 foot setback from the high water line has been established. No structure shall be erected in this zone.*

There appears to be a possible conflict with the public interest, in that it may negatively affect water quality, and violates recorded limitations established by the developer in order to maintain the shoreline and environment. The seawall portion of this request seeks to improve the environmental conditions by limiting erosion, after the native vegetation has been removed, however it still conflicts with the plat requirements. If a Variance to Bonner County Revised Code is granted, the applicants will still need to address the plat requirements, as shown in the proposed Conditions of Approval.

**G. Stormwater plan**

A stormwater management plan is required pursuant to BCRC 12-720.2. A Stormwater Management Plan has been submitted as file #ST0003-25, and is pending this variance.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the requested impervious surface coverage variance V0030-25. Limiting impervious surface coverage in the areas near surface water bodies helps protect water quality by limiting the amount of direct stormwater runoff into streams and lakes that can carry sediment and other contaminants into surface water. While an individual variance may have minimal localized impacts, the cumulative effects of multiple variances that result in increased impervious surfaces near surface water within the watershed can be expected to have a negative impact on water quality over time. DEQ recommends maintaining the limits in established codes wherever possible, and considering individual variances carefully for very unique situations.
