Public Hearing Action Items **File ZC0005-24 - Zone Change - Rural-10 to Rural-5.** The applicant is requesting a zone change from Rural 10 to Rural 5. The 124.46-acre property is zoned Rural 10. The project is located off Callen-Crabb Road in Section 18, Township 56 North, Range 1 West, Boise-Meridian.

File CUP0005-24/S0001-24 - Conditional Use Permit - Eagle Estates PUD (S0001-24). The applicant is requesting a large scale planned unit development in conjunction with a total of 110 residential lots on a 39.4-acre parcel. The overall density will be 1 residential home per 15, 484 square feet. The 39.4- acre property is zoned Rural Service Center. The project site is located off U.S. Highway 57 in Section 25, Township 60 North, Range 5 West, Boise-Meridian.
