REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL WOOD GRINDING AND DISPOSAL

Bonner County Solid Waste seeks a statement of proposal, qualification and price per ton, from companies licensed and qualified for grinding, transportation and proper disposal of the wood piles listed below.

1. Purpose:
Grind, transport and properly dispose of the wood piles located at the Colburn Transfer Station (Sandpoint), the Idaho Hill Transfer Station (Oldtown) and the Dickensheet Transfer Station (Priest Lake)
2. Equipment and Labor:
 - a. Contractor to provide:
 - All necessary grinding equipment
 - All necessary labor to complete the grinding operation
 - Transportation and disposal of wood in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations
 - Any permits or certifications needed to perform the work
 - b. Contractor Requirements:
 - Submit prior experience information
 - Proof of worker's compensation insurance
 - Proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 annual aggregate
 - Must name Bonner County as also insured
 - \$3,000.00 performance bond to be submitted upon award
3. Work to be performed:
 - a. Contractor shall be responsible for the grinding, transportation and proper disposal of the wood piles at the locations listed above. **No debris shall be left at any of the collection sites.** Existing piles must be ground within an acceptable time frame that the Contractor and County establish.
 - b. Contractor shall keep detailed logs of work performed as to the quantity of the debris at each location.
 - c. Notice of where debris is disposed.
 - d. Location, Date and time of job start and end
 - e. Number and names of staff working
 - f. Hours of operation shall be 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday
 - g. Contractor shall notify Bonner County Solid Waste office one (1) day prior to the arrival to the site where the grinding will occur.

4. Length of contract/funding

- a. The contract will be for the current fiscal beginning October 1, 2019 and ending on September 30, 2020
- b. Award of this contract does not guarantee work in the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2019
- c. Bidders can determine the total number of tons by visiting each of the three sites
Previous contract quantity for the contract period 10/1/2017-9/30/2018

Colburn 5,344 Tons
Idaho Hill 1,223 Tons
Dickensheet 340 Tons
Total 6,907 Tons

Submit to Bonner County your proposal, qualification and the cost per ton for the grinding, transportation and disposal of the brush and wood piles located at the three locations identified above. Include all of the required information listed above.



All statements of proposals and quotes must be returned to Bonner County Board of Commissioners, 1500 Highway 2, Suite 308, Sandpoint, ID 83864, by 9:00 a.m. (prevailing local time) on Friday, September 13, 2019 and opened by the Bonner County Board of Commissioners at that time.


The statements and prices will be reviewed and ranked by Bonner County Solid Waste personnel. Bids will be screened and ranked by the statements and prices paid to Bonner County per ton, based on the criteria described above. The selection team reserves the right to conduct interviews of the bidders or to make a decision directly from the proposals. 


