Idaho listed noxious weeds that are categorized as EDRR (early detection, rapid response) are either new invaders to Bonner County, or infest limited acreage. These noxious weeds may be treated by Bonner County for no charge—the Idaho State Department of Agriculture provides cost sharing funds to Counties to help them achieve eradication of their EDRR noxious weeds. We just need permission to work on your property; see *Agreement Form—New Invaders (EDRR) Treatments*.

If you see something unfamiliar or out of place, there is a good chance that it is! Bonner County does not want to see EDRR noxious weeds elevate to widespread levels—that’s when resources degrade and treatments become expensive. We need help from the public with discovering infestations, just beware of look-alikes. Reference our handbook for additional pictures and descriptions. If you suspect you have spotted one of the below offenders, bring in a sample to our office for positive identification.
