### **Idaho Noxious Weed Categories in Bonner County:**

EDRR Noxious Weeds - Early Detection Rapid Response (New Invaders & Small Infestations)

**EDRR list** – infest limited acreage across the county; some on only one site.

Hoary Alyssum
Large Knotweeds (Bohemian/Giant/Japanese)
Leafy Spurge (eradicated at last check)
Rush Skeletonweed
Scotch Broom* (see footnote)
Scotch Thistle
Small Bugloss
Tansy Ragwort
Yellow Flag Iris

<u>EDRR watch list</u> – Idaho noxious weeds that are not confirmed as being in Bonner County, but are confirmed in surrounding areas of the region. Would be treated as high priority EDRR if infestation is confirmed.

Common Reed (Phragmites)
Hoary Cress (Whitetop)
Policeman's Helmet
Puncturevine
Vipers Bugloss (Blueweed)

\*: Includes statewide prohibited genera Cytisus, Genista, Spartium & Chameacytisus. Common names include but are not limited to Scotch Broom, French Broom, Portuguese Broom, Moonlight Broom and all related varieties & cultivars.
