Idaho Noxious Weeds in Bonner County – Categorized:

Applicable Idaho Statute §: Title 22, Chapter 24

Governing Idaho Administrative Rule: IDAPA 02.06.09

EDRR Noxious Weeds - Early Detection Rapid Response (New Invaders & Small Infestations)

EDRR list – infest limited acreage across the county; some on only one site. Eradication is the goal.

Cogon Grass** (see footnote)
Common Reed (Phragmites)
Large Knotweeds (Bohemian/Giant/Japanese)
Leafy Spurge
Saltcedar (Tamarisk sp.)
Scotch Broom* (see footnote)
Scotch Thistle
Small Bugloss
Tansy Ragwort
Yellow Flag Iris

Watch list – Idaho noxious weeds that do not have a confirmed presence in Bonner County, but are confirmed in surrounding areas of the region. Prevention is the goal. Would be EDRR by default if infestation is confirmed.

Idaho Noxious Weeds in Bonner County – Categorized:

Control list – moderate infestation levels; the goal is to suppress populations, prevent spread and possibly eradicate site specific pioneering colonies.

Diffuse Knapweed
Field Bindweed
Hoary Alyssum
Hoary Cress (Whitetop)
Houndstongue
Perennial Sowthistle
Purple Loosestrife
Rush Skeletonweed

<u>Containment list</u> – widespread infestations; long term management goals aimed at maintaining high use areas and travel corridors to reduce further spread, and to abate populations for resource protection.

Curlyleaf Pondweed (state managed)
Dalmatian Toadflax
Eurasian Watermilfoil (state managed)
Flowering Rush
Hawkweeds – Orange & Yellow
Oxeye Daisy
Spotted Knapweed

Bonner County Invasive Weeds of Concern; these are not on the Idaho Noxious Weed List, therefore not subject to the associated statutes & rules, nor is there a county ordinance stipulating control. As a courtesy to landowners, Bonner County recognizes these invasive weeds as secondary targets on county rights-of-way & properties, based on landowner input. Most have a widespread presence.
