## NEIGHBORHOOD COOPERATIVE - COST SHARE PROGRAM

### General Information & Program Requirements

1. Cost Share application packets include two pages to be submitted prior to herbicide treatments, and two pages to be submitted at the conclusion of the project. Submission deadlines are **May 31, 2026** for pages 1 & 2 of the application packet, and **August 31, 2026** for pages 3 & 4 (along with the herbicide receipts).
2. The County Noxious Weeds Director will review all applications, and contact you upon approval. Two or more parcels are required to be listed on the application. Lands used for commercial crops do not qualify. Weeds treated must be on the Idaho noxious weeds list.
3. Coordinators must keep copies of all actual receipts (not statements) + proof of payment (credit card transaction slip, check copy, check detail or bank statement reflecting cash transaction) for herbicides purchased, as well as detailed spray records. If the project is performed by a commercial applicator, be sure the applicator itemizes labor and herbicide/surfactant costs. Labor charges are not reimbursed, but time spent & equipment used needs to be recorded on page 3 for the cost share match. Ensure the receipt(s)/invoice(s) are printed cleanly and that all content is readable. **Only approved herbicides & spray additives** qualify (see page 1 of the packet or contact the Noxious Weeds Director).
4. Neighborhood Cooperative Cost Share reimbursements are capped at a maximum of **\$500.00** per individual landowner for eligible herbicides purchased and used, as backed up on page 4 of the packet. Claims under \$500 may be reimbursed in full (minus sales tax), funds permitting. In the event there are reduced funds, a formula will be established to equitably distribute the funds. Reimbursement checks are usually issued in October.
5. Herbicides must be used in accordance with all label instructions and safety precautions.
6. Reimbursements are at the sole discretion of the Bonner County Board of Commissioners. The obligation of Bonner County to provide the cost share reimbursement program is subject to appropriated funds for this program; no refund guarantee can be made. This is a grant program utilizing state funds, with a small county supplemental fund. No obligation of funds can be made beyond the current fiscal year.
