MINUTES FOR THE BONNER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING

July 14, 2026 – 9:00 AM

On Tuesday, July 14, 2026, the Bonner County Commissioners met for their regularly scheduled meeting. Commissioners Domke, Williams, and Korn were present. Commissioner Korn called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. The Invocation was presented by Charlyn Wright and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

ADOPT THE ORDER OF AGENDA AS AMENDED

Commissioner Domke made a motion to amend the order by removing the Sheriff's Office Items as they do not have a representative to present. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. There was a brief discussion. Roll Call Vote: Commissioner Williams – Yes; Commissioner Korn – Yes; Commissioner Domke – Yes. The motion carries.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve Resolution, number to be assigned, regarding the continuation of the Family Advocate Intake Specialist Position and the Continuation of Supplemental Salary Allocations to key CAC personnel to ensure the ongoing provision of high-quality, trauma-informed services to child victims and their families throughout FY2027 as indicated in the memo provided.
