Bonner County Noxious Weeds List:

EDRR Weeds – Early Detection Rapid Response

EDRR tier 1 – less than 100 acres in region and/or only infested on one site in the region

Jointed Goatgrass
Leafy Spurge
Policeman's Helmet***
Small Bugloss
Scotch Thistle
Tansy Ragwort

EDRR tier 2 – less than 500 acres in region

Large Knotweeds (Bohemian/Giant/Japanese)
Poison Hemlock
Purple Loosestrife
Rush Skeletonweed
Scotch Broom*-
Yellow Flag Iris

EDRR watch list – weeds that are not confirmed as being in Bonner County, but are confirmed in surrounding areas of the region; includes weeds that have been eradicated in Bonner County. Would be treated as EDRR tier 1 if infestation is confirmed.

Common Reed (Phragmites)
Hoary Alyssum
Hoary Cress (Whitetop)
Vipers Bugloss (Blueweed)
Yellow Starthistle

*-: Includes statewide prohibited genera Cytisus, Genista, Spartium & Chamaecytisus. Common names include but are not limited to Scotch Broom, French Broom, Portuguese Broom, Moonlight Broom and all related varieties & cultivars.

Containment list – region efforts to contain populations and prevent further spread

Control list – reduce or eliminate expanding weed populations

Roadside Undesirables List – Vegetation not treated as noxious weeds, nor listed at the state or county level as noxious weeds, but not tolerated in operational zones on county roadsides for reasons ranging from drainage ditch impediments to visibility hazards and visual nuisances.
