MINUTES FOR THE BONNER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING

September 4, 2018 – 9:00 A.M. Bonner County Administration Building 1500 Hwy 2, Suite 338, Sandpoint, ID

On Tuesday, September 4, 2018 the Bonner County Commissioners met for their regularly scheduled meeting with Commissioners Bailey, McDonald & Connolly present, and Chairman Bailey called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. The Invocation was presented by Pastor Chris Bassett and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

ADOPT ORDER OF THE AGENDA

Commissioner Connolly moved to adopt the order of the agenda as presented. Commissioner McDonald seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.

2) Action Item: Discussion/Decision Regarding Contract for Hazardous Fuels Treatment, Northwest Logging Company

Commissioner McDonald made a motion to approve and sign the Contract for Hazardous Fuels Treatment between Bonner County and Northwest Logging for project work on the BONFire program funded by an Idaho Department of Lands Grant in the amount of \$100,000.00 with no County match. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.

This agreement sets forth the conditions under which Bonner County will house juveniles under the jurisdiction of Boundary County. The term of the agreement is for a period of 2 years ending September 30, 2020. Commissioner McDonald seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.

ROAD & BRIDGE - Steve Klatt

1) Action Item: Discussion/Decision Regarding Acceptance of Grader Lease Financing; 3.74% Fixed Annual Rate, \$149,771.14

Commissioner McDonald made a motion to approve the Road and Bridge Department to solicit a five year lease agreement with Columbia Bank for the lease-purchase of one John Deere grader. Financing will be provided at the 3.74% fixed annual rate for a total five year lease cost of \$149,771.14. The formal Columbia Bank financing agreement will be submitted to the BOCC Board - Commissioners Glen Bailey, Daniel McDonald & Jeff Connolly, for review and approval at a later date. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.
