## Recertification Training

Recertification Training is pesticide training specifically designed to enhance the knowledge of pesticide applicators that are currently licensed.

To maintain certification, the applicator must complete a specified amount of recertification within a the license period. The goal of the recertification program is to provide training for applicators that will continually increase their level of competency.

The requirement for recertification credits for professional categories is 15 credit hours during the license period and 6 credit hours during the licensing period for private applicators.
