Grants

Budget Transfer from "B" budget to "D" budget

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may adjust the budget as adopted, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Grants' "A" budget has unspent budget authority, and

WHEREAS, the Grants' "D" budget has approximately a \$29,000 deficit, and


WHEREAS, the county wants to balance each departmental budget at year-end by reducing said deficits by using the unspent spending authority within that same department.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County authorize the Clerk to open Grants' "A" and "D" budgets and reduce 047-6020 (Salaries – Deputies) by \$29,000 from \$500,000 to \$471,000 and increase 047-6150 from \$0 to \$29,000.
