## Budget Transfer from "B" budget to "A" budget

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may adjust the budget as adopted, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, Veterans' Services "A" budget has approximately a \$2,400 deficit, and

WHEREAS, the county wants to balance each departmental budget at year-end by reducing said deficits by using the unspent spending authority within that same department.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County authorize the Clerk to open Veterans' Services "B" and "A" budgets and reduce 00122-6450 (Travel) by \$2,400 from \$4,200 to \$1,800 and increase 00122-6060 (Salaries – Full Time) from \$51,588 to \$53,988.
