Technology

Budget Transfer from "C" budget to "D" budget

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may adjust the budget as adopted, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and,

WHEREAS, the Technology "C" budget has unspent budget authority and,

WHEREAS, the Technology "D" budget has approximately a \$4,000 deficit, and

WHEREAS, the county wants to balance each departmental budget at year-end by reducing said deficits by using the unspent spending authority within that same department;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Bonner County authorize the Clerk to open the Technology budget and reduce 00115-8570 (Software Purchases) by \$4,000 from \$70,000 to \$66,000 and increase 00115-6150 (Medical Insurance) from \$40,647 to \$44,647.
